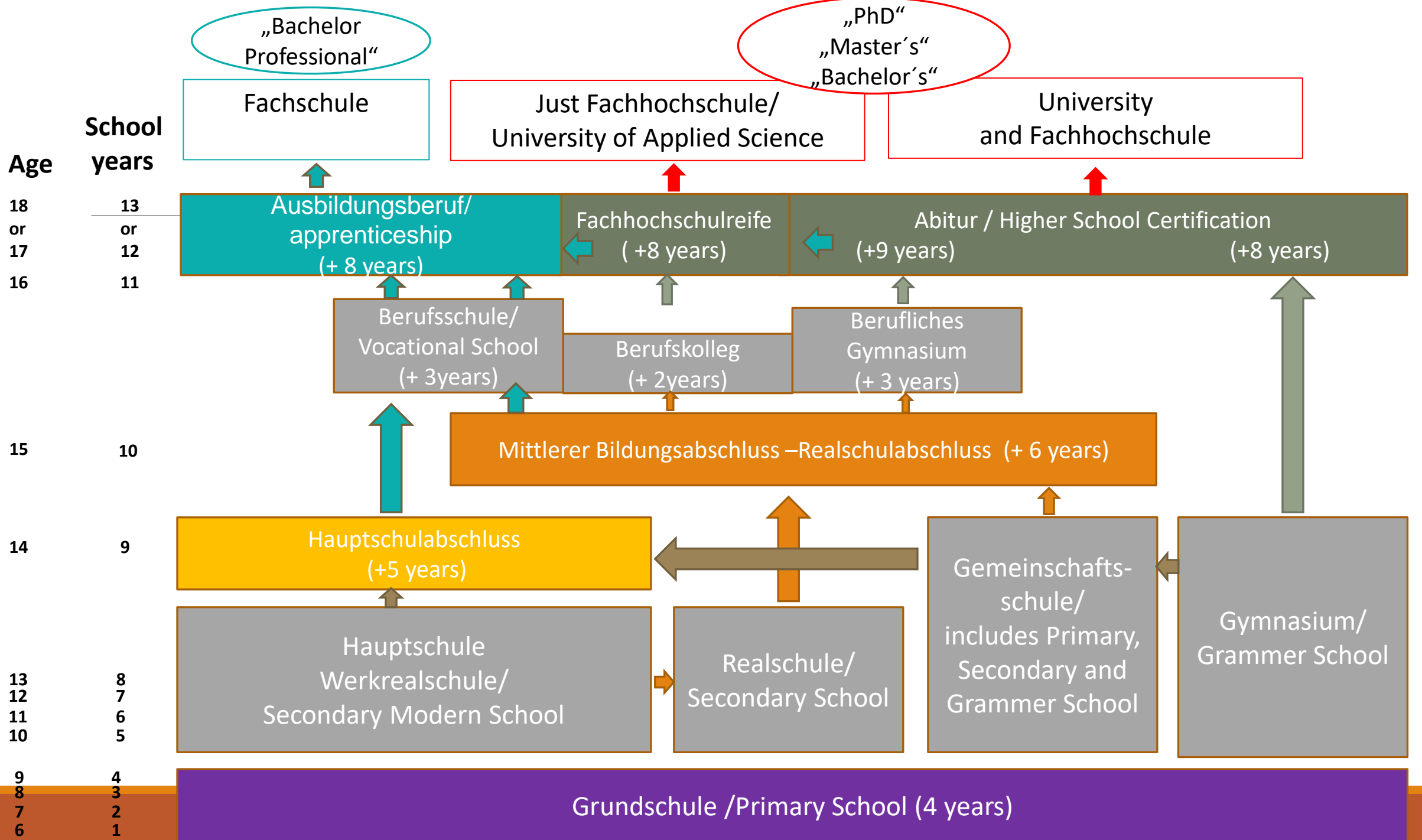

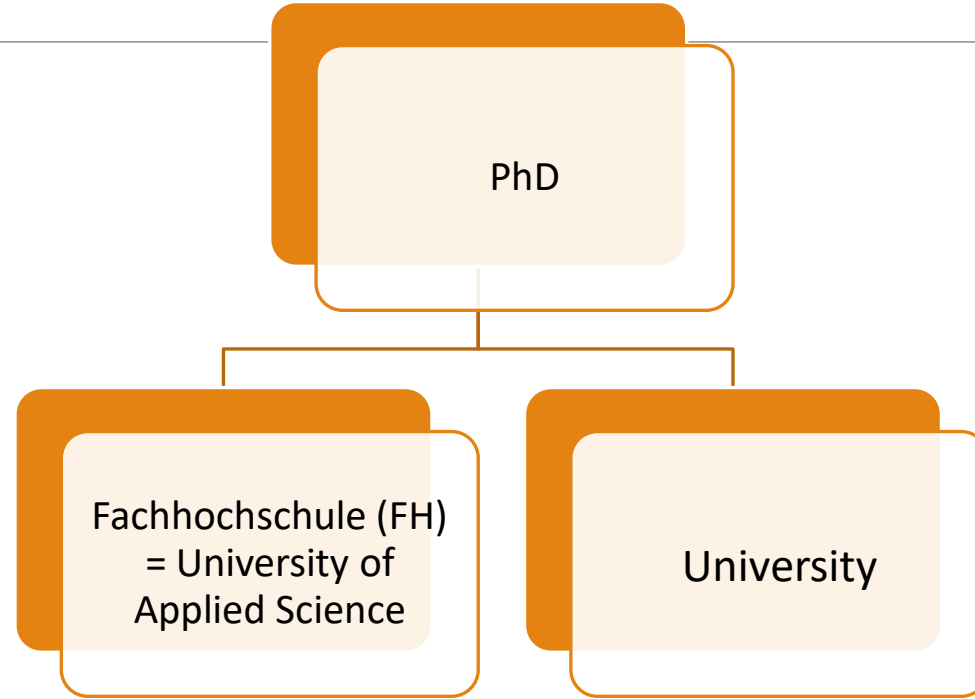

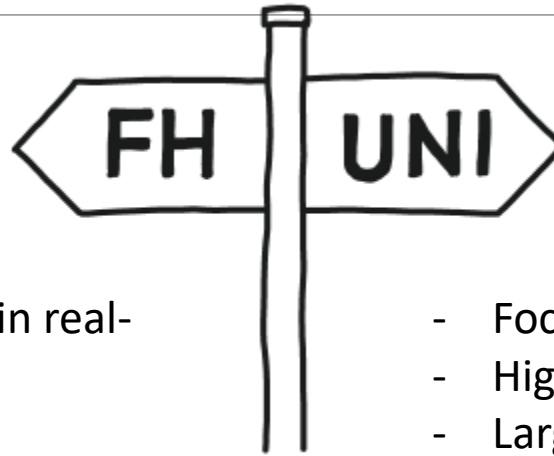

- Both offer Bachelors and Masters programs
- Same system of grades and credit points
- Both require attending lectures, seminars, and exams
- Both provide academic credentials and degrees

What is different?



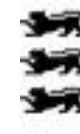
- More practical education and experience in real-life companies with integrated internship programs
- Less flexible in certain subjects
- Lower number of students per instructor: 20 -30 students per classroom. Able to interact more personally with professors and friends
- More job-oriented
- Postgraduate programs at TU are possible

- Focus on theoretical and research based studies
- Higher workload
- Larger number of elective choices
- Larger number of students per instructor: 100 - 300 students per classroom → Less interaction with professors and other students. More students can lead to lesser attention.
- Greater focus on academics

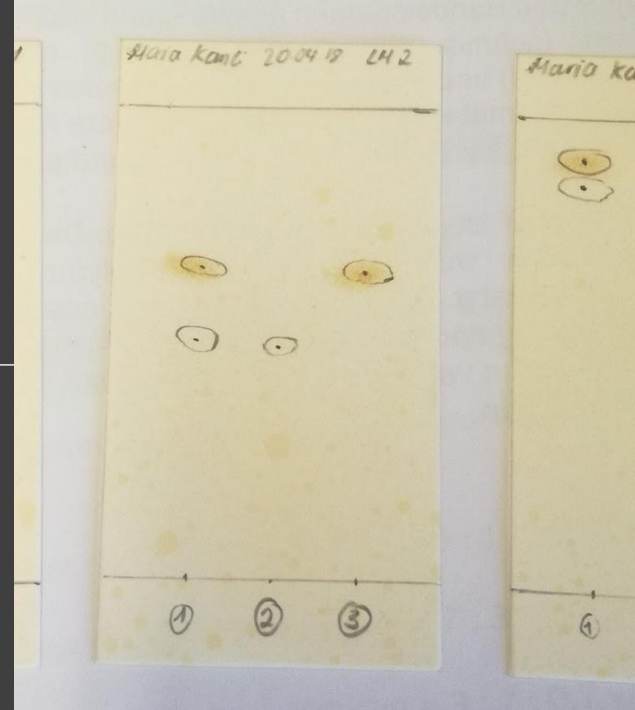
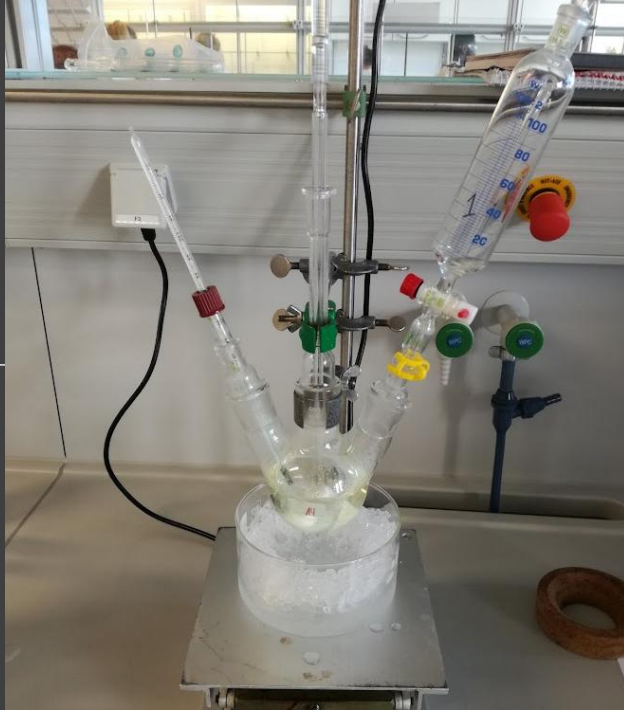
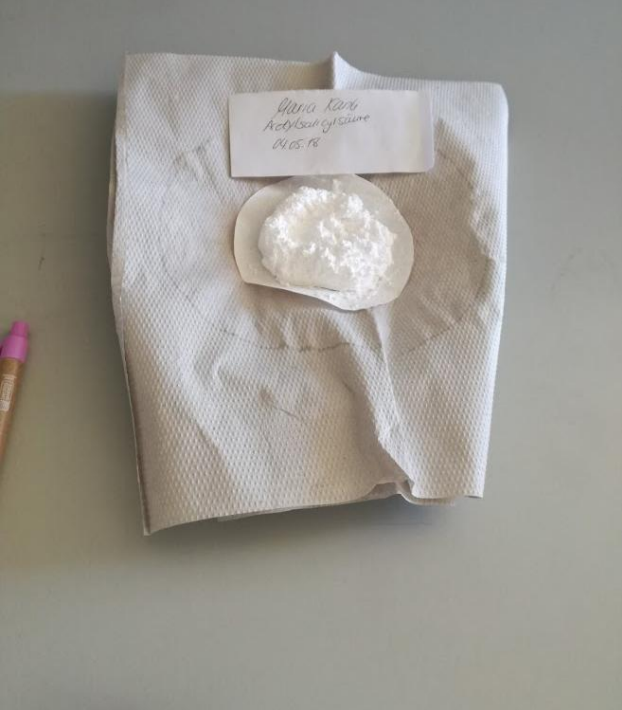

- The standard period of a Bachelors program is usually 7 (210 ECTS) semesters and can be extended up to a maximum of 10 semesters.
- For the internship semester, students usually need to have completed a certain amount of ECTS credits before starting their internship. You can find all specific informations in the module manual of each study program.

- The standard period of a Bachelors program is usually 6 (180 ECTS) or 7 (210 ECTS) semesters and can be extened by a maximum of three semesters
- For the internship semester students usually need to have completed a certain amount of credits before starting their internship. You can find all specific informations in the module manual of each study program.
